Application Checklist

To better facilitate Rebate Application processing, please submit Rebate Application and supporting documentation at least 6 weeks prior to proposed interconnection.

All UEC Net Metering Program applications must be accompanied by the following attachments to be considered complete:

- Completed and signed Interconnection Application
- One-line electrical diagram that shows the location of the electric meters and disconnect switch.
- Property site sketch or drawing
- Manufacturer equipment cut-sheets
- System sizing and production estimate.
- Copy of customer contract for PV system equipment and installation, indicating total installed cost.
- Submit payment of non-refundable application fee

Each of the Undersigned declares that:

- I have read and will comply with the provisions of the UEC Net Metering Rules;
- The information provided in this form is true and correct to the best of my knowledge;
- The site of installation is permanently located within UEC's service territory;
- My intent is to operate the system at the listed site of installation for its useful life; and
- If I trench, I agree to disclose the location of easements and call 811 for locates or "Call Before You Dig".

Upon receipt of all required attachments and completion of initial review of the project documentation, a Confirmation letter or e-mail will be sent from UEC indicating preliminary project approval. Please note that installation of your PV system may commence only after you have received your Confirmation notice. Installation prior to approval notification may disqualify project for a UEC rebate.

Customer notification that the project is complete, and receipt of signed Interconnection & Net Metering agreement along with all required post installation documentation, UEC will conduct an onsite inspection and install the UEC solar production monitoring meter.
